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Social Emotional Wellness Sub-Committee

Actionable Steps

- Identify screener for students most at risk
- Identify, monitor and support students in need of mental health/emotional support services.
- Implement strength based practices that empower students and staff with self awareness, self regulation and stress management skills.
- Provide SEL tools, practices and supports to students and staff in order to promote social, emotional and academic growth and competence.

Considerations when planning:

- Integrated support for staff
- Use learnings from current experience
- Provide tools that cultivate executive functioning for students
- Cohort Planning safety, staff, facilities, siblings, childcare, etc.

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Instruction Sub-Committee

Actionable Steps

- Determine instructional option based on student needs and in alignment with Public Health
- Identify universal benchmark screener
- Prepare contingency plans based on varied needs
- Training and Education for all stakeholders

Considerations when planning:

- Cohort Planning safety, staff, facilities, siblings, childcare, etc.
- Hold Students Harmless Acceleration/Remediation
- Students with Specialized Services
 - Special Education, 504, English Learner, etc.
- Nimbleness of contingency plans
- Learnings from current experience
