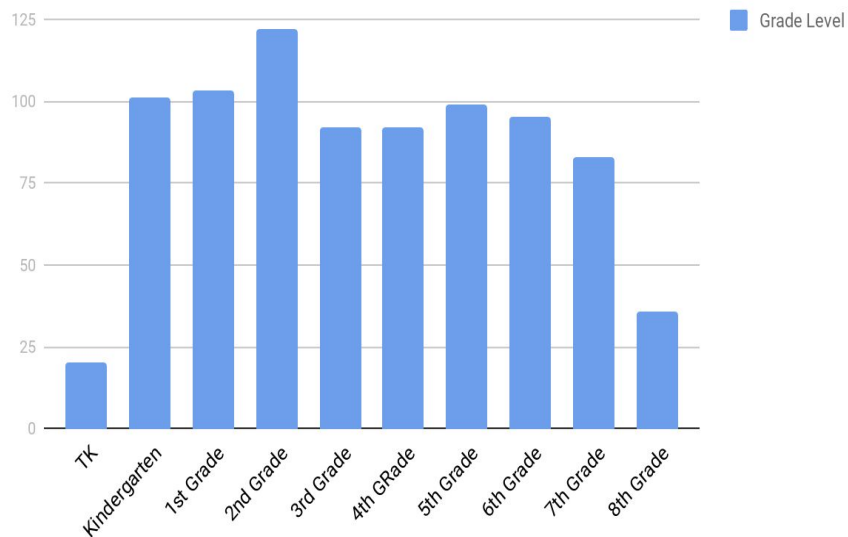

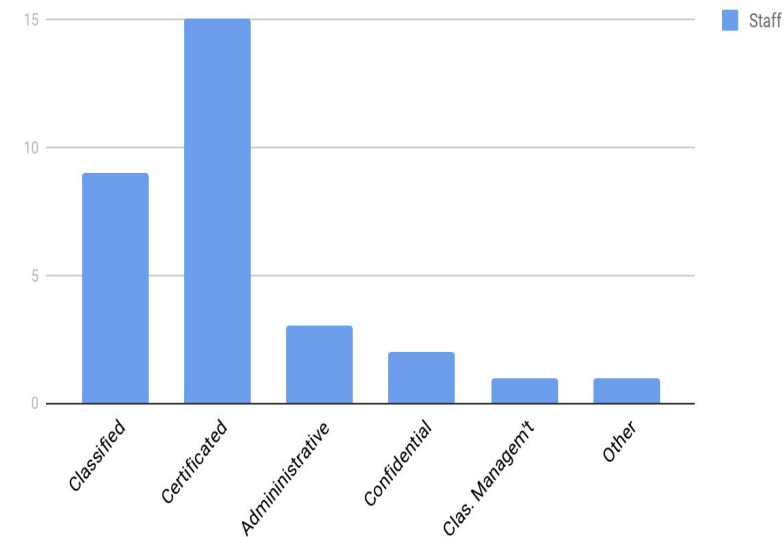

Grade Level Response Representative - Total 820

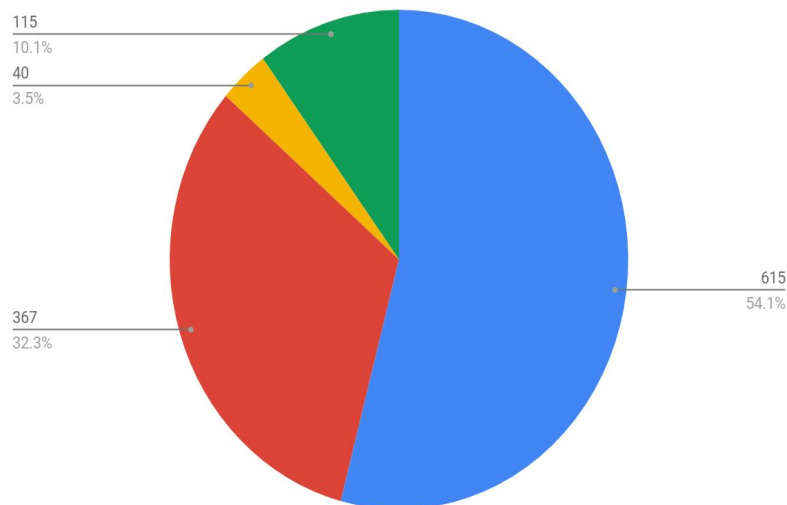


Staff Response - Total 31

I would send my child to school if daily classes are in full operation. (615 - 54.1%)

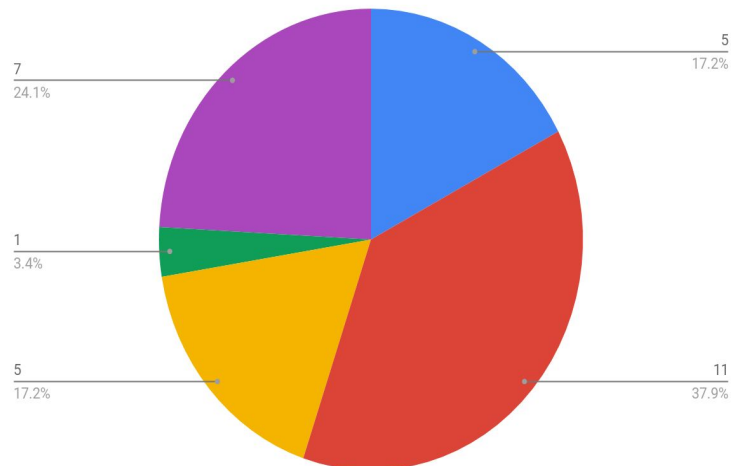
I would send my child to school with a hybrid model of in-person classroom based instruction and distance learning. (367 - 32.3%)

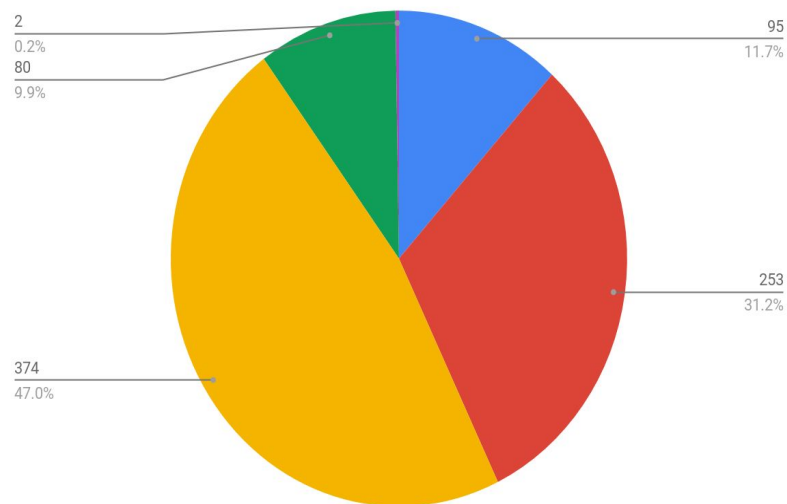

Engaged - (253 - 31.2%)

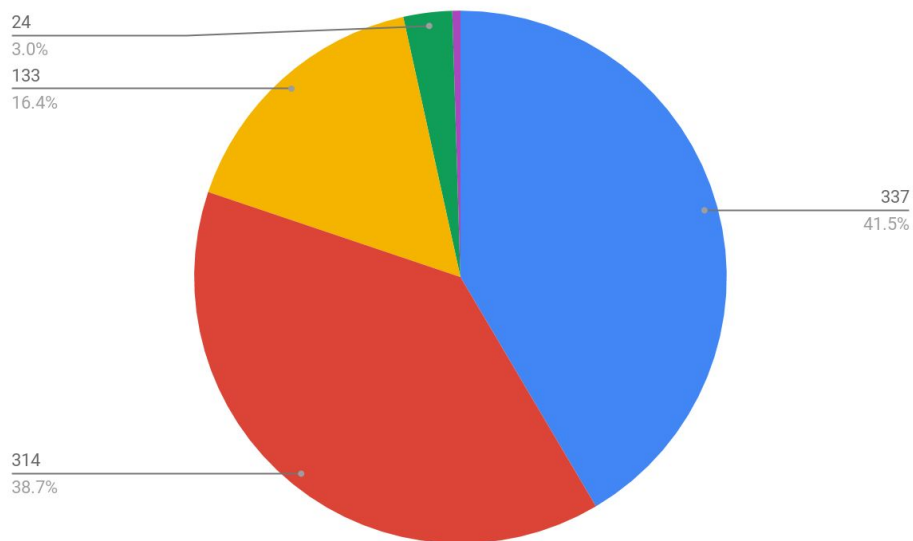
Somewhat engaged - (374 - 47.0%)

Budget Implications

Overarching Budget Takeaways

- **Federal Aid** - CARES Act & ESSER Funds
 - **Rejects** 10% reduction to LCFF Calculation
 - Anticipates **Deferrals or IOU's**
 - Maintains **pension relief** - for two years
 - **Distance Learning** Definition
 - *Conditions to employ, what it means & what it shall include*
 - **Instructional Time**
 - *Number of days (180) will be maintained, but the minimum requirements for annual instructional minutes are waived.*
