## Key Considerations

- Safe school operations based on local health data
- Prepare sites with required safety measures for adaptability as permissible
- Communicate school operation plans to support families and students
- Drive down Prevalence - Reduce Transmission

## Waiver Process

- Adherence to the MCPH/MCOE 30 Point Plan
- School Site specific protection - safety plan
- COVID-19 Testing
- Prioritize - outdoor learning & education equity
- Earliest Opportunity for In-Person Sept. 8
- Waiver Application Released - Friday, Aug. 14

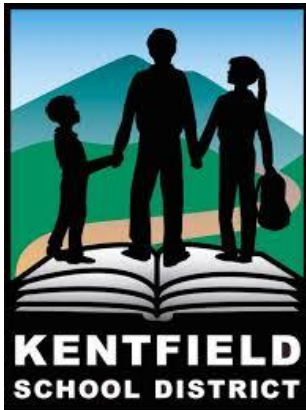

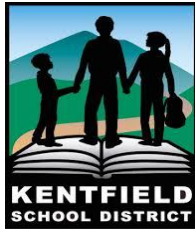
