At its meeting on Tuesday, the Board of Trustees heard a status report on the Measure D Bond projects underway in the district. Construction at Kent is now concentrating on the administrative complex at the front of campus, and the music classroom toward the east side. Modernization of classrooms that was scheduled for the summer has all been completed. Architectural plans for Bacich's projects are being submitted to the state architect for review in the next few weeks.

Preparations are nearly complete for a survey of the community about our Parcel Tax. Godbe Research will be contacting as many voters in our school district as possible in the next few weeks via phone, email, and text. If you are contacted for your opinions, we would greatly appreciate it if you took the time to offer them. At its October meeting, the Board will get a report on the results of the survey and recommendations from our consultant Charles Heath of TBWB on next steps. This meeting is open to the public and all are welcome.
