This month's Educational Showcase highlighted the Language Arts program at Bacich and Kent, particularly <u>Writing Workshop</u>. Sixth grade teacher, Sandy Wells, along with students, Chloe O'Shea and Simone Sarfaty, described several of the processes employed by students to increase the volume of their writing and improve its quality. Third grade teacher, Methinee Bozeman, and first grade teacher, Lisa Cicurel-Jones, shared examples of the development of student writing from TK-K through fourth grade, also utilizing Writing Workshop.

Emergency Plans were approved by the Board for <u>Bacich</u> and <u>Kent</u>. This is an annual process that follows the October drill on both campuses.
