

Kentfield School District Board Meeting Highlights

November 10, 2015

Teachers Jennifer Sterling, Elizabeth Teasdale, Rebecca Jelen and Myra Anderson presented an overview of the new Readers Workshop component of the English Language Arts program at Bacich and Kent. Videos and live presentations by students in Kindergarten through 5th grade highlighted various aspects of this approach to teaching reading that focuses on the “just right” level of difficulty in books students choose. A slide show on the Bacich website outlines the myriad ways this approach to teaching reading improves on approaches used in the past.

The Board has scheduled a Special Meeting and Study Session on December 3rd at 4:15 p.m. in the District Office Board Room to approve a contract with our Measure D Bond projects architects, QKA, and to learn of their impressions of our Master Plan. Master Plan Steering Committee members and any other interested parties are invited.
