THE POSITION

The Board of Trustees of the Kentfield School District invites highly qualified educational leaders to apply for the position of superintendent. The superintendent will provide leadership for the educational program and operations of the school district which includes Bacich Elementary and Kent Middle Schools. A strong background in curriculum and instruction, successful experience as a teacher and school leader, and a track record of success in helping all students excel and closing the achievement gap are essential. Our next leader will have values and beliefs that support equity and the implementation of the goals in our updated strategic plan. He/she will work closely with our school leaders, maintain a high degree of visibility on school sites, and assist with the effective operation of our schools. Strong fiscal and personnel management skills are also important along with the ability to provide effective support systems for our English Language Learners and Special Education students. This is an excellent opportunity for a dynamic, innovative, highly ethical and equity minded leader to work with students, staff, Board, and a supportive community to build on our strengths and help all our diverse students achieve the high standards we have established.

SELECTION PROCESS

The Board of Education has retained Consultants Marc Ecker, Ph.D., Jim Brown and David Verdugo, Ed.D. of Leadership Associates to recruit qualified candidates. The consultants will screen applications and recommend candidates to the Board for interviews and further consideration. Any contact with board members, in an attempt to influence the selection process, will be considered a breach of professional ethics. Finalists will have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the community and schools. Board members reserve the right to visit the District and communities of a candidate prior to a final decision.

SALARY AND CONTRACT

The salary will be competitive and based upon qualifications and experience. A multi-year contract will be considered.

THE DISTRICT

The Kentfield School District is located in Kentfield, CA and is comprised of two school sites: Bacich Elementary School, grades TK/K-4 and Kent Middle School, grades 5-8. Enrollment for 2019-20 is approximately 1,183 students.

The Kentfield School District is highly regarded by its parents, students and greater school community. The District is known for having strong core academic programs along with rich visual and performing arts, physical education, Spanish language, technology and character education curricula.

The average class size in grades TK/K-4 is 22.5 and in grades 5-8 it is 26.1. The District enjoys the generous support of its active PTA, School Site Councils, and the Kentfield Schools Foundation, a non-profit organization. In addition, the District has been very successful over the past two decades in passing parcel tax and facilities bond measures. In March 2018, the community renewed the District's Parcel Tax for 10 years which will generate approximately \$50 million total. The annual budget is approximately 19 million. The District embraces the growth of its Spanish speaking population.

THE COMMUNITY

The Kentfield School District is located 18 miles north of the Golden Gate Bridge and San Francisco and close to the famous Muir Woods and near the seashore. Kentfield/Greenbrae is a suburban community with 6,800 residents and sits within Marin County which offers an unparalleled combination of natural beauty and comfortable living. The wonderful climate allows year-round outdoor activity. Though generally sunny and warm throughout the region, some of the coastal areas experience summer fog. Kentfield and Greenbrae residents enjoy a wide array of outstanding recreational opportunities nearby and within a short driving distance, including the beautiful beaches and parks, and a number of bike paths. Exceptional arts and cultural activities, historical landmarks and other entertainment opportunities make the Kentfield area a desirable community.
